Conestoga Township B.O.S Minutes November 7th 2017

CALL TO ORDER- The Supervisors meeting was called to order at 7 pm by Eshleman.

PRESENT- Supervisors, Craig Eshleman, John Berry, and Robert Hershey Jr, Secretary Naomi Little, Citizens; Attendance list attached.

MINUTES- The Supervisors approved the October meeting minutes on a motion by Berry, second by Hershey Jr. All in favor none opposed.

BILLS- The Supervisors approved all bills paid during the month of October on a motion by Eshleman, second by Hershey Jr. All in favor none opposed.

TREASURER'S REPORT- Report was provided by Terry Shepps on table for review. Approved on a motion by Berry, second by Hershey Jr. All in favor none opposed.

ZONING REPORT- Read by Eshleman, for W. Lampeter: there were 5 permits issued and 3 permits in review.

ROAD MASTER REPORT- Road Crew spent time doing general maintenance, milling and patching potholes. Laid black top:18 tons on Orchard lane, 24 tons on Stoney Lane, 10 tons on Colemanville Rd, and 7 tons on River Rd. Finished measuring road width and right a ways for Penn Dot. Cut and cleaned up trees on Stoney Lane and Duck Hill Rd. Replaced a lot of damaged signs on Pequea Creek Rd and Sickman's Mill Rd. Road signs damaged by Williams were replaced and documented for reimbursement.

POLICE REPORT- Read by Officer Gary.

CONDITIONAL USE

MARTIN- Conditional Use and Lot Add On were approved on a motion by Berry, second by Hershey Jr. All in favor none opposed.

KYPER- Conditional Use was approved with restrictions of no outside displays or storage, no outside lighting, hours of operation would be from 10-5 Thursday Friday Saturday and 12-5 Sunday. Also any signs would need to be permitted by Zoning. Motioned by Eshleman, second by Berry. All in favor none opposed.

OLD BUSINESS

GRANT INCREASE FOR RINEER RD- Grant for Rineer Rd was increased an extra \$1,500.00 to total the amount of \$9,539.30 in grant funds to work on the project.

COLMANVILLE SEWER UPDATE- Residents that are hooked up to the Colemanville sewer system have been notified with a letter from the Twp Solicitor to make arrangement to pay any past fees for service. All 8 houses have responded and are complying with payments and or payment arrangements.

537 PLAN UPDATE- The Twp is collecting information for the 537 task action report along with exploring options for grant and low interest loans to help cover future costs of the 537 plan.

TOWNSHIP BUDGET- Budget was approved on a motion by Berry, second by Hershey Jr. All in favor none opposed.

SRPC UPDATE- Berry has met with Conestoga Solicitor, Pequea Solicitor, Pequea Supervisor Cynthia Evans, Commission board member Steve Yinger, and Commission Solicitor to discuss information on options on closing Commission and handling liability tail insurance along with final pay, payouts for sick time, and possible unemployment compensations. The Board asked for Berry to continue further discussion on contracting police services and headquarter lease with Fire Dept. along with the other addressed topics. The 2016 audit and late pension issues will be addressed once the final audit and response from Attorney General is received.

POLICE SERVICE- More information about options for police services was discussed. Some of the options were: buying service hours from other departments, state police, SRPD, or a hybrid of both state and contracted services.

NEW BUSINESS:

UCC EDUCATION FEE- Fee increase of 50cents was approved on a motion by Eshleman, second by Berry. All in favor none opposed.

BARD LETTER OF CREDIT- Credit letter for Bard was no longer needed after review from Twp Engineer. Release was approved on a motion by Eshleman, second by Berry. All in favor none opposed.

INSPECTION LETTERS- Letter for septic inspection reminders was approved on a motion by Eshleman, second by Hershey Jr. All in favor none opposed.

Gambling Resolution- Eshleman would like to have the resolution to prohibit gambling in the Twp put on next month agenda for review.

GENERAL PUBLIC

Robin Maquire asked why the Twp Road crew would have to upkeep with issues from Williams such as knocked down road signs ect. Berry and Hershey Jr. answered that it is the Twp responsibly to repair and upkeep any issues to stay with in code and provide a safe environment for the Twp. Any costs incurred from Williams will be noted and reimbursed to the Twp. Also the Board will remind Williams to stay on the roads that are bonded.

Tim Buyers and Ben Vonderhide inquired about the progress with the police services. Berry stated that he is currently in meetings with the Twp Solicitor and Pequea to discuss options with services and also closing of the SRPC. Berry said that issues will need to be addressed regarding the 2016 audit not being done yet and the late pension aid paperwork, if the pension is not approved by the Auditor General it could result in the Twp having to pay in a portion.

Dianna Good asked who was responsible for the paperwork and what will be done to remedy the issue. The Board answered that the Pension Plan Administrator and Commission Board are responsible and will need to follow up on paperwork to ensure timely responses to the problem.

Dianna Good and Tim Buyers asked that if funds needed would be extracted from the budgeted amount for the police services or cost the Twp extra money? Berry and Hershey Jr. replied that if the funds were needed for the pension they would come out of the budgeted money.

Ben Vonderhide- Announced he has taken papers regarding issues with the police dept. to the Attorney General for review. He suggested that taking a year apart from SRPD services would give the dept. time to clear up any issues and be better prepared to contract service with the Twp at a later date.

Dianna Good inquired if there was any progress on the ambulance services. Eshleman stated that he had given the ambulance dept. a call a few days ago and did not get a response yet.

Fred Warfel stated that the ambulance dept. should have a log to show where the ambulance is and times they are servicing the area.

Tim Buyers asked that if the ambulance dept. does not get back to the Board with answers to these questions would the Board look into getting the Solicitor involved.

Gaye Denlinger asked to find out if the ambulance dept. will still honor the service that people have paid dues for.

John Wiker- Asked to have an issue with the rail trail near his farm reviewed by the Twp. Berry said he would get in contact with the Twp Engineer to meet with Wiker and look into a solution that will suit everyone.
