CALL TO ORDER- The Supervisors meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by Berry.

Daniel Alexander presented a letter to the Board resigning from his position on the Planning Commission effective September 4, 2018.

Robin Maquire inquired on why the Road Crew was working on the roads that were bonded for Williams. The Board informed here that there are bad pipes that need to be replaced and the Twp. would like to have them done before the paving. That way the new paving would not have to be damaged and we would not be paving over bad pipe.

Scott Kriner asked if Robert Hershey Jr. would excuse himself from any decisions on any new projects on his property on Sand Hill Rd. Hershey Jr. explained that the decisions have already been made with the Conditional Use hearing and if any other decisions would be needed it would be through Zoning and not involve the Board of Supervisors.

Eric Doman stated that he thinks the Township is doing good and is in the right direction.

Andy Collins asked if the Twp. is getting State Police Reports, the Board stated that the reports are available on the front table.

Scott Kriner asked if the Twp. receives a percentage of the fines paid for tickets, which was answered that the Twp. does.

Robin Maguire wanted to know if it was determined how the new 537 Plan's cost would be determined. Berry answered that the Plan will need a loan and the Township is budgeting now and creating a plan for payment. There may be a tax increase to help with costs.

Gay Denlinger asked if LEMSA will be sending out membership cards, the Board stated that they will be sending them out in November.
