CALL TO ORDER- The Supervisors meeting was called to order at 7pm by Berry.

State Trooper Pevalko gave a police report for the year, he said the numbers haven't really changed from 2018-2019. He informed the Residents about a new program that has been implemented to have Troopers come out to meet with schools and spend time with the students. He informed everyone that if there are any issues, or information rather it be speeding, criminal activity or any questions to please call the State Police Department.

Scott Kriner- Thanked Trooper Pevalko for the dept. services and stated that he appreciates their involvement with the schools.

Doris Warfel- Asked if Conestoga and Pequea are completely separated and finalized yet in regards to SRPD property. The Board stated that the Townships are still going through the look back period until next year.

OLD BUSINESS:

2020 Township Budget-Approved on a motion by Hershey Jr. second by Rankin. All in favor none opposed.

Terry Shepps- stated that the Township has a strong balanced budget that is building reserves and allowing investment back into the Township. He stated that the Township was very prepared and ready for the budget process.

Berry stated that the budget has allowed room for the Township to be able to purchase a 350 super duty ford with a utility box and a plow. Also, a 550 ford dump truck with plow and

spreader for the road department. Also the Board is looking into replacing the flooring along with volunteer help with painting for the pool.

Road Crew New Hires- Steve Long was hired as a part time Road Crew position at \$18/hr.

Motion by Berry, second by Hershey Jr. All in favor none opposed.

Bryan Morris was hired as a part time Road Crew position at \$18/hr. Motioned by Hershey Jr. second by Rankin. Rankin and Hershey Jr. in favor, Berry abstained from vote due to being related to Mr. Morris.
