**Berry** updated the public on the Rail Trail; there are two grants that have been obtained for the restoration of the trestle; one from DCED – Multimodal Transportation for \$750,000.00 and also from DCED- Greenways, Trails and Recreation for \$250,000.00. He hopes that if another grant from DCED can be obtained that it would be possible to start the biding process for the work on the Trestle in 2020.

**Terry Shepps** asked if the process will be jointly controlled by both Martic and Conestoga Townships. Berry stated that yes both Townships are working together on the project.

Wes Bruckno asked what the grants would cover the total cost of restoration. The Board stated that if all the grants are obtained then it would cover the cost of the whole project.

**Berry** informed the public that Halloween Trick or Treat will be on Thursday, October 31<sup>st</sup> from 6-8pm.

**Ray Hess** Captain of the Fire Police informed the public that the Volunteer Fire Co. will be helping out with Trick or Treat. He said that they will be out to support the area but it would not be easy to close the road. He stated that it should be the responsibility of the parents to watch their children.

**Berry** agreed that he did not know of any other Township that has closed the road for Trick or Treat and it could by more challenging since it is a state road.

**Terry Shepps** commented on the Township's financial condition, stating that the Township's budget is healthy and growing.

George Mentzer with the Department of Defense presented a Patriot Award to John Berry. Tyler Hertzog had nominated Berry for the award; he is an active service member in the Army Reserve and had worked on the Conestoga Township Road Crew and Pool. This award is to acknowledge the support of Mr. Berry of Conestoga Township as a Patriotic employer.
