GENERAL PUBLIC

Rob Buterbaugh 186 Spring Run Rd. and Scott Weber 85 Spring Run Rd inquired about the dirt road on Spring Run Rd. Berry stated that the road was abandon from the breaker up to their properties in the 2011 BOS minutes. Therefor the abandon area has been turned back to the adjacent owners as private property. Berry asked for them to notify PPL of any changes done to the area since they have an easement through the property.

Janet Roark 18 Sweetwater Drive and Suzanne Jones 20 Sweetwater Drive have concerns over a neighboring property that has been doing access burning, junk on the property, possible drug activity, and general disturbances to the neighborhood. The Board asked that they contact the State Police about the disturbances and Berry said he would follow up with the State Police and Zoning about the issues. Robert Hershey Sr. asked about getting the Township to dedicate Hershey Lane, he is working with the Twp. Engineer to have the road up to the PennDot specks before it would be turned over to the Township. This agreement was made over 15
